

Revegetation Equipment Catalog Preparation

There is a major need to provide revegetation specialists with current sources of information on revegetation equipment. To meet this need the Revegetation Technology and Equipment Council (RTEC) in cooperation with the Forest Service and Bureau of Land Management has initiated a project to produce an equipment catalog which will be published on the World Wide Web. The web-based publication will allow for updates, and it will permit widespread access. There will be a description, applications, photograph(s), and vendor contact information for each type of equipment. The text will be prepared and reviewed over a 2-year period. In the third year, the catalog will be formatted for the web and tested for user-friendliness. Equipment categories will include tractors, all-terrain vehicles, brush and weed control, site preparation, seeding, seed collection and processing, transport, and miscellaneous. Examples of equipment write-ups will be shown. Information on equipment you have found to be useful in revegetation is requested.
